





#### Patents

- Purpose: Exclude others from making, using, or selling the invention
- Inventor vs. owner:
  - Where could AI fit in?
  - Does AI even need patent protection? Even many companies are not seeing the point.

Copyrights: Gives a creator the right to reproduce, publish, or display an original work of art

- AI's creations
- AI = "creator"?

But AI *doesn't* get IP rights. So what does this mean?






